Application Procedure And Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 1. Simply pour the contents of the sachet into the paint can and stir until the paint solidifies. 2. Leave for 2 hours with the lid off. 3. Remove the hardened paint from the can, wrap in newspaper and then dispose of via domestic waste - Once the hardened paint has been removed, recycle the steel can via council kerbside recycling. Disposal of empty paint containers via recycling programmes may differ between local authorities. Check with your local council first. - One 25g packed will solidify 500mL of paint. Only add the recommended dose. <p>IMPORTANT: Use this product in an open environment. Leave lid off at all times during the mixing and solidifying process. Do not shake.</p>
